Club Business:

Officer training will be offered again on January 25, 2013, at Lilly Corporate Center in downtown Indianapolis. We have already had two officers trained (Horstman, Labore) during the winter training cycle and we need to have two more trained. Claxton plans to attend this training.

Labore plans to organize a Toastmasters Youth Leadership program during spring break (March 17-20) and needs volunteers to help. Former member Paul Pottle may rejoin the club and help John.

Our current membership stands at 7. Since we started the club year at 8, we need to reach 13 (net gain of 5) to be eligible for distinguished club status. That leaves us at a deficit of 6 members we need to achieve this goal.

Claxton proposed a spring open house to attract new members. Horstman and Claxton offered to co-chair the event. Tentatively scheduled for February 25. Claxton will draft notification for the Greenfield newspaper.
